(1) ADMINISTRATOR.—The term "Adminis-
trator" means the Administrator of the Environ-
mental Protection Agency.
(2) Data of economic harm.—The term
"data of economic harm", with respect to a major

facts, and figures that can be measured, traced, and
validated with respect to the economic harm that is
anticipated to be caused by the major EPA-promul-
gated rule or rulemaking.
(3) Data of environmental harm.—The
term "data of environmental harm", with respect to
a major EPA-promulgated rule or rulemaking,
means data, facts, and figures that can be meas-
ured, traced, and validated with respect to the envi-
ronmental harm that would be caused without the
promulgation or issuance of the major EPA-promul-
gated rule or rulemaking.
(4) Major epa-promulgated rule or rule-
MAKING.—The term "major EPA-promulgated rule
or rulemaking" means a final rule or policy of the
Administrator—
(A) the promulgation of which was not ex-
plicitly authorized by an Act of Congress; and
