2 Section 1614(a) of the Food, Conservation, and En3 ergy Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 8789(a)) is amended—

4 (1) by striking "funds for producers" and in5 serting the following: "funds for—

7 (2) in paragraph (1) (as so designated), by
8 striking the period at the end and inserting the fol9 lowing: "; or

"(2) agricultural producers to construct or upgrade storage facilities for propane that is primarily
used for agricultural production (as such term is defined in section 4279.2 of title 7, Code of Federal
Regulations (as in effect on the date of the enactment of this paragraph)).".
