SBA Disaster Recovery Resources



Businesses and homeowners in an area covered by a Presidential Disaster Declaration are eligible for SBA Disaster Loans. **Iowans in the following counties affected by the severe storms, tornadoes, and flooding on May 20-21, 2024, are eligible for SBA disaster assistance:**

- Eligible for Physical Disaster and EIDL Loans: Adair, Montgomery, Polk, Story
- Eligible for EIDL Loans Only: Adams, Audubon, Boone, Cass, Dallas, Fremont, Guthrie, Hamilton, Hardin, Jasper, Madison, Marion, Marshall, Mills, Page, Pottawattamie, Taylor, Union, Warren

SBA Disaster Loans for Businesses and Homeowners



Home Loans up to \$500,000 to replace or repair the **primary residence**.



Personal Property loans up to \$100,000. Renters and homeowners may repair or replace items such as clothing, furniture, cars, and appliances.



Business Physical Disaster Loans up to **\$2 million** for real property, equipment and other business items. Businesses of all sizes and most private nonprofits are eligible.



Economic Injury Disaster Loans up to \$2 million for working capital. Small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, and most private nonprofits are eligible.

Iowa Disaster Recovery Centers

SBA is offering in-person assistance to homeowners, renters, business owners, and nonprofits. A FEMA representative will also be present to answer questions.
