Dear Mr. President:

We respectfully ask that you promptly grant the request made by Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds for a major disaster declaration for the State of Iowa as a result of severe weather and heavy rainfall between July 1 and July 4, 2026, that produced high winds, severe flash flooding, and massive overtopping across central Iowa's river basins. This severe weather caused significant damage to public infrastructure and private property.

Governor Reynolds has requested Hazard Mitigation statewide and activation of the Public Assistance Program. Public Assistance was requested for Jasper, Polk, Story, and Warren Counties.

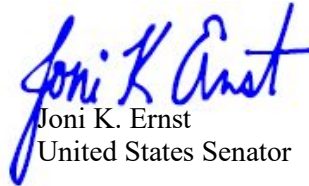

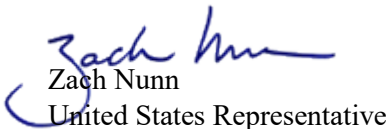
