A BILL

To rescind unused COVID funding and reduce the deficit.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Returning Unspent
5 COVID Funds Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RESCISSION OF UNUSED COVID FUNDING.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b), effec-
8 tive on the date of enactment of this Act, the unobligated
9 balances of amounts made available under the following
10 are rescinded:

11 (1) The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021
12 (Public Law 117–2; 135 Stat. 4).

1 (2) Division M or N of the Consolidated Appro-
2 priations Act, 2021 (Public Law 116–260; 134 Stat.
3 1182).

4 (3) The Paycheck Protection Program and
5 Health Care Enhancement Act (Public Law 116–
6 139; 134 Stat. 620).

7 (4) The CARES Act (Public Law 116–136; 134
8 Stat. 281).

9 (5) The Families First Coronavirus Response
10 Act (Public Law 116–127; 134 Stat. 178).

11 (6) The Coronavirus Preparedness and Re-
12 sponse Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2020
13 (Public Law 116–123; 134 Stat. 146).

14 (b) NATIONAL SECURITY WAIVER.—Amounts de-
15 scribed in subsection (a) that were made available for an
16 account or program shall not be rescinded if, not later
17 than 60 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the
18 President submits to the Committee on the Budget of the
19 House of Representatives and the Committee on Finance
20 of the Senate a notice waiving the rescission under sub-
21 section (a) with respect to the account or program.

22 (c) USE FOR DEFICIT REDUCTION.—Amounts re-
23 scinded under subsection (a) shall remain in the general
24 fund of the Treasury for the sole purpose of deficit reduc-
25 tion.
